樹仁學院與英國格萊摩根大學合辦

會計及財務專業本科榮譽學位課程（第一部份）招生簡章

（一）宗旨

旨：本課程之設，旨在協助有志成為專業會計師之本港青年，有機會在本港先學習一年，奠定良好穩固之基礎，然後獲保送入英國格萊摩根大學，再進修二、三年，以完成會計及財務學榮譽學士學位。

（二）課程結構

本課程由英國格萊摩根大學與樹仁學院簽訂合作協議，包含二部份，第一部份包括必修學科六科，全部在樹仁學院完成。第二部份包括第二、三年課程及另一年實習（選修）在格萊摩根大學完成。各科考試達一定水準者，可獲格萊摩根大學頒授會計及財務學榮譽學士學位。在港修讀之第一部份課程為下列七科。

- (1) 初級會計
- (2) 經濟學原理
- (3) 數學技巧
- (4) 組織行為學
- (5) 商業組織與管理
- (6) 法律簡介
- (7) 商業軟件應用

如完成上述七科，考試成績平均達C級（績點二·三或以上者），即有資格直升入格萊摩根大學會計系二年級。

（三）優點

點：

（1）在本港攻讀會計系一年級課程，顯而易見可節省時間與金錢，即是會計及財務學榮譽學士學位課程的三分之一在港完成，大為縮短留英學習的時間與費用；且已建立良好之基礎，更具信心與把握，所獲實益甚大。

（2）本課程包括一年實習訓練。英國格萊摩根大學負責分派學生到各大機構，作支取薪金的實習，以汲取實際工作經驗及薪酬。現并獲本港大公司贊助，接受學生支薪實習。

（3）完成全部課程，可獲該大學頒授學士學位，此項學位與該校所頒其他學位完全一樣。

（4）獲頒學位後，投考會計師公會專業考試，可獲免考八卷。

（5）樹仁學院圖書館，添置有適當書籍，以協助學生充分準備升級考試。

（四）申請入學資格：本課程為照顧中六學生之入學需要，特設基礎課程及一年級課程，共須在樹仁修讀二年。但中七畢業生，則可直接申請入讀一年級課程，於一年內完成。

（A）投考基礎課程者，須具下列資格

會考包括中、英文六科合格，並曾在認可之中學修讀一年中六者，可參加本校之入學試。

（B）投考學位課程者

（1）須持有香港高級程度考試合格證書，可申請免考筆試；或

（2）曾參加倫大入學考試、考獲二「A」三「O」者；或

（3）年齡在廿一歲以上之成年學生，具有相當學術水平，及良好之英文程度者唯須參加本校於九六年八月四日（星期日）舉行之入學考試。

Co-operative Programme for the B.A.(Honours) Degree in Accounting and Finance between

Hong Kong Shue Yan College and The University of Glamorgan, U.K.

Introduction

The programme is designed for those aspiring to be a professional accountant, but with insufficient time or resources to pursue a degree course in Great Britain. The successful applicant will be able to do the first year of a four year sandwich course right here in Hong Kong and best of all, this is not a correspondence course. The syllabi, teaching materials and examination papers of subjects taught at Shue Yan College are fully compatible with those at the University of Glamorgan. Degrees will be awarded by the University of Glamorgan, degree classification will be based on studies undertaken in United Kingdom.

Aim

To facilitate the transfer of students from Hong Kong Shue Yan College to the second year of the B.A. Honours Degree (in Accounting & Finance) Programme at the University of Glamorgan.

Structure

The four year (Honours) Degree Programme is divided into two parts. Part I comprising six subjects is taught in its entirety at Shue Yan College in Hong Kong. Part II comprising 2nd & 3rd year studies plus a period of Supervised Work Experience will be conducted at the University of Glamorgan. The syllabi and examination papers of Part I of the Co-operative programme are compatible with those at Glamorgan. The seven subjects offered in Hong Kong are:

Accounting
Economics
Quantitative Techniques
Organizational Behaviour
Business Organization & Management
Law
Information Technology

Students who have successfully completed the examinations of the above subjects with an average of at least C (G.P.A. 2.3) will be eligible to transfer to the second year of the B.A. (Honours) Degree course at the University of Glamorgan.

Attractions

1. Substantial savings are realized by undertaking one third of the complete course locally, stemming from lower tuitions and living expenses.
2. The programme, which is a sandwich course, includes a year of Supervised Work Experience. The University of Glamorgan will endeavour to find training places for all students, which provide them with an opportunity to gain practical experience.
3. The degree is awarded by the University of Glamorgan and is identical in every respect to that resulting from their regular programme.
4. Upon receiving the B.A. (Honours) Degree, the ACCA will grant exemptions of 8 papers of the Professional Examination to the graduates.
5. The Library of Shue Yan College offers appropriate text books and periodicals in order to assist the students to prepare for the first year examinations.

Eligibility for Admission

(A) Foundation Course

Students who have passed HKCEE with at least 6E grades including Chinese and English in one examination and who have successfully completed one year of Form Six studies in a registered school are required to take the College Entrance Examination.

(B) First Year of the co-operative B.A. (Honours) Degree

- (i) Students who have passed the H.K. Advanced Level Examination or its equivalent will be eligible for exemption from the written part of the College Entrance Examination. or
- (ii) Mature students aged 21 or above with a good command of English (shown in public examination) plus 2-3 years' relevant working experience may also apply. However, this category must sit for the College Entrance Examination.

- i) please bring originals and copies of academic qualifications including transcripts/reports of Form 4 to Form 7, Hong Kong Identity Card and two recent passport size photographs.

 - iii) submit the completed form with copies of supporting documents and a non-refundable application fee HK\$100.00.

Entrance Examination

(A) Each candidate must attend an interview at an appointed time arranged immediately after submitting his/her application to the Registry.

(B) The written examination will be held on Sunday, August 4, 1996 at the College.

Tuition Fee

A tuition fee of HK \$26,000.00 per academic year is payable in 2 equal instalments, i.e. H.K.\$13,000.00 per semester, once paid, is non-refundable.

The tuition fee for Part II is per University of Wollongong schedule.
