The programme is designed for young people aspiring to the modern commercial field, who are limited in time or resources but would like to pursue a full degree course in Australia. The successful applicant will be able to do the first two years here in Hong Kong i.e. completion of 48 credit points out of total value of 144 and best of all, this is not a correspondence course. The syllabi, teaching materials and examination of Wollongong in Australia papers of subjects taught at Shue Yan College are identical to those at the University of Wollongong. Degree will be awarded by the University

The purpose of this programme is to make more accessible to Hong Kong students the opportunity of higher education in Australia

average of 2.25 or better, will be eligible to transfer into the second year of the Bachelor of Commerce at the University of Wollongong than 48 credits, passed the specified Shue Yan College subjects with a mark of C (2.0) or better, and have obtained a cumulative grade point Students who have successfully completed the first two years studies at Shue Yan College and obtained aggregate specified credits not less who have 2 passes in the Advanced Level Examination shall complete one year's study at Shue Yan. Those who have passed the

specified subjects with a grade point average of 2.3 or better are eligible to transfer to the University of Wollongong, which will grant them exemptions from 36 credits out of total value of 144. They are required to take two more years to obtain 108 credits at the University for completing the requirements for the award of the Bachelor Degree in Commerce.

Attractions

- Substantial savings are realized by undertaking one third of the whole course locally, stemming from lower tuitions and living expenses
- The degree awarded by the University of Wollongong is identical in every respect to that of their regular programme Those who have been awarded the degree are eligible to apply for the right of abode in Australia. Two years study at Shue Yan College will assist students in building up a sound foundation.

Eligibility for Admission

There are Foundation Course and First Year Degree Course:

- (A) Entry into the Foundation Course: Students of this category (A) are required to take 2 years to complete the Part I programme

- Ξ At least 6 passes including Chinese and English in one sitting in HKCEE; and Completion of Form Seven study in one registered secondary school in Hong Kong;
- (B) Entry into the First Year Degree Course: Students of this category (B) are required to take only one year to complete the Part I programme. (iii) Pass the College Entrance Examination.
- Ξ At least 6 passes including Chinese and English in one sitting in HKCEE; and At least 2 passes in the HK Advanced Level Examination; OR
- At least 2(A) and 3(O) and a pass in English in the GCE Examination; OR
- Mature students aged 21 or above with a good command of English may also apply, but this category must pass the College Entrance Examination
