

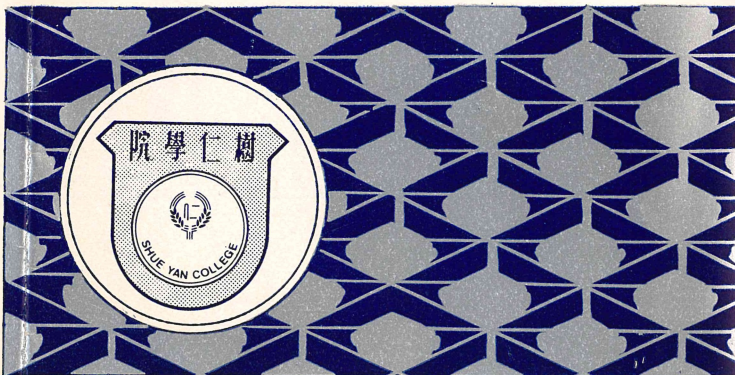

(一) 宗旨：發揚仁愛精神，推廣學術風氣。培植有志青年，使具有現代化實際而專門之學識技能及完善品格，以服務社會，造福人羣。

(二) 特色：着重思考與追求真理，務期學以致用。故第一、二年為通才教育，奠定健全基礎；三、四年則注重探討專門的高深理論及配合實習訓練，務使學生與現實社會不致脫節。

(三) 校址：大專部：香港跑馬地成和道八十一號全座。電話：五十七三三一二三，五十七四八七三八。
中學部：灣仔峽道七號全座。電話：五十七二五八九二，五十七二二六七六。

(四) 系別：分日、夜兩部，所有課程師資，完全相同。計有下列各系
中國文學系，歷史學系，英國語文學系。
法政系，法商學系，會計學系，工商管理學系。
新聞學系，社會及輔導學系，社會工作學系。

(五) 招生：(甲) 一年級新生。
(乙) 二、三年級轉學生。

(六) 投考資格：(甲) 投考一年級者，須具下列資格之一：
(1) 持有香港中學畢業會考證書，會考成績在同一考試中五科E級以上（包括中英文兩科在內），並曾在認可之中學六年級修讀一年者，或
(2) 曾在註冊中學修畢六年課程，並於一九六五年或以前領有香港中文中學會考證書，其中中、英文兩科合格者。
(3) 海外僑生具有同等學歷，經本院個別審查特准報名與考者。
(4) 香港大學或香港中文大學入學試及格，或倫敦大學普通教育文憑試及格持有証書者。（得申請免考筆試）
(乙) 二、三年級轉學生：

(1) 須具備一年級入學資格，並繳交原校成績表，証明轉校前成績良好者。
(2) 師範學院或文商學院畢業者。
△凡中文、英文及數學成績良好者，將獲優先考慮。

(七) 報名日期：六月三日至七月卅一日，每日上午九時半至下午六時半。（例假休息）
地點：香港跑馬地成和道八十一號本院教務處。
手續：(甲) 報名時須携備學歷證件正本及副本。
(乙) 最近二吋半身照片三張。
(丙) 報名費港幣肆拾元，取錄與否，概不發還。

(八) 考試科目：考生必須考中文、英文二科，並在下述各科中選考一科，共三科。
中國歷史、歷史、地理、公民、經濟與公共事務、數學。

(九) 入學考試：入學試定於八月一日在本院舉行（核准免考筆試者除外）。
筆試：一年級考生於接獲筆試及格通知，或轉學生於接獲審查合格通知，須於指定時間內來院面試，逾期概不受理。
面試：一年級考生於接獲筆試及格通知，或轉學生於接獲審查合格通知，須於指定時間內來院面試，逾期概不受理。

(十) 學費：新生及轉學生學費一律每學年貳千元，分十期繳交，即每期二百元。另須繳保證金壹百元，畢業前自動離校或毀壞公物或遺失圖書者均不發還。

(十一) 註冊及選科：一年級新生須於九月一、二日（星期三、四），二、三年級轉學生於九月三、四日（星期五、六）按指定時間辦理註冊及選科手續。

(十二) 開學：九月十一、十二日（星期六、日）新生指導營
九月十五（星期三）正式上課。

附告：

凡在本院大專部修業二年以上，成績優異者，可升入美國路易士安納州立東北大學、杜倫大學、三藩市大學、威斯康辛大學或貝門學院三年級攻讀。本院畢業生可入該等大學攻讀碩士學位。

Prospectus, 1976 - 77

1. **Aim:**

The College aims to promote the spirit of humanity and to provide the youth of the community with suitable climate and facility for (i) the intensive pursuit of truth, knowledge and wisdom; (ii) making contribution to the creation of a better society.

2. **Characteristics:**

With a view to bringing students' initiative in their academic pursuits into full play and combining theory with practice, emphasis will be laid on general education and wide knowledge in order to build a sound foundation for the first two years and on the intensive study of specialized theories combining with practical training for the third and fourth year, which enable the graduates to meet the need of Hong Kong society.

4. **Departments:**

Department of Chinese Literature, Department of History, Department of English Language and Literature.
Department of Business and Law, Department of Accounting, Department of Business Administration.
Department of Journalism, Department of Sociology, Counselling & Guidance, Department of Social Work.
Department of Law & Administration

5. **Admission:**

- (A) First year students of all Departments.
- (B) Second and Third year transfer students.

6. **Qualifications for Admission:**

(A) **FIRST YEAR STUDENTS.**

- (1) have passed the Hong Kong Certificate of Education Examination with at least five E grade subjects, including Chinese and English in one examination and have completed the Form Six study in a registered school, or
- (2) have completed a six-year course in a registered secondary school and passed the Hong Kong Chinese School Certificate Examination in or before 1965, or
- (3) have attained equivalent education standard from oversea countries, or
- (4) have matriculated either from HKU or CUHK or have passed the General Certificate of Education Examination of the University of London with at least three Ordinary and two Advanced level subjects (students of this category are eligible for exemption of written part of the Entrance Examination).

(B) **TRANSFER STUDENTS.**

- (1) have possessed the qualification specified in 6 (A) above and have evidence to show that their academic achievement in the previous universities or colleges are satisfactory or
 - (2) have graduated from one of the Colleges of Education or the Evening School of Higher Chinese Studies.
- Priority will be given to applicants of good academic achievement in Chinese, English & Mathematics.

7. **Application Procedures:**

- (A) **Date & Time:** June 3, to July 31, 1976. 9:30 A.M. - 6:30 P.M. daily.
(office closed on Sundays).
- (B) **Place:** Registry, Shue Yan College, 81, Sing Woo Road, Happy Valley, Hong Kong.
- (C) **Documents:**
Applicants should produce the original and one photo copy of each of their certificates, diplomas or/and transcripts and records and three recent photographs (size 2" X 1½").
- (D) **Fee:**
HK\$40 per applicant, this fee will not be refunded whether or not his/her application for admission is successful.

8. **Subjects of the Entrance Examination:**

Each Candidate must take Chinese, English and one of the following subjects:
Chinese History, History, Geography, Economics and Public Affairs, Civics, and Mathematics.

9. **Date of Examination:**

- (A) The written examination will be held on August 1 (Sun) 1976 at the College.
- (B) All applicants must attend an interview at a time appointed by the College after notification of success in the entrance examination or initial application.

10. **School Fees:**

A tuition fees of HK\$2,000 per year payable in ten equal instalments, i.e. HK\$200 per month.
A deposit of HK\$100 which will not be refunded if the student leaves the College before his graduation or makes damage to College properties or loses books borrowed from the College Library.

11. **Registration:**

- (A) For First Year students, it is Scheduled on 1st - 2nd (Wednesday & Thursday) of September, 1976.
- (B) For transfer students, it is Scheduled on 3rd - 4th (Friday & Saturday) of September, 1976.

12. **Commencement:**

Orientation: 11th and 12th (Saturday and Sunday) September, 1976.
Classes begin: 15th (Wednesday) September, 1976.

13. **Special Announcement:**

Second year students of the College showing outstanding academic promise may be recommended by the President of the college for transfer, if they so desire, to the third year of studies at the Northeast Louisiana State University, University of San Francisco, University of Wisconsin or other colleges and universities. Graduates of this College may be recommended for study of Master's Degree.

The College has been recognized by the Hong Kong Government as an approved post-secondary College registered under the Post-Secondary Ordinance. A holder of the Diploma awarded by Hong Kong Shue Yan College is entitled to enter grades of the civil service as laid down by the Government for recognized post-secondary graduates.

A new campus at Braemar Hill, North Point, now under construction, will be completed within two years.
