## 樹仁學院與英國列斯特大學合辦

### 經濟學本科榮譽學位課程第一年（暨基礎課程）招生簡章

#### （一）宗旨：

本課程之主要目的，在協助本港青年有志赴英攻讀經濟學榮譽學位者，能在港先學習一年（或入基礎課程、修業兩年），奠立良好穩固基礎，然後獲保送入英國列斯特大學二年級，再進修二年，以完成經濟學榮譽學士學位。

#### （二）課程結構：

本課程由英國列斯特大學與樹仁學院簽訂合作協議而開設，原則上三年完成。但第一年全部課程可在樹仁一年（或二年）完成。第二三年課程共九卷，在英國列斯特大學完成，各科考試合格，成績達一定水準者，可獲該大學頒授經濟學榮譽學士學位。此第一年學位課程、實際上即是樹仁學院經濟學系第一、二年所開設之全部課程，其中第一年等於列斯特大學的基礎課程，專為已完成一年中六預科的學生而設。而本學院的第二年課程，則等於該大學學位課程的第一年。凡完成了兩年預科（中七畢業生），在高級程度考試中，考獲二科合格者，即有資格修讀。但須補修基礎課程中的主修科目（如在高級程度考試或 GCE「A L」中該等科目合格，則可免修）基礎課程及第一年學位課程包括下列十科：

凡樹仁學院經濟系或商學院其他系學生，完成上述各科，成績合格，平均分爲乙下（B）可申請，經考試甄選合格者，獲推荐升入該英國大學經濟學學士學位課程二年級。

#### （三）優點：

（1）在本港攻讀經濟系一年級課程，顯而易見可節省時間與大量金錢，即是經濟學榮譽學士學位課程的三分之一在港完成，大爲縮短留英學習的時間與費用；且建立良好之基礎，更具信心與把握，所獲實益甚大。

（2）再赴英繼續進修二年，完成全部課程，可獲列斯特大學頒授學士學位，此項學位與該大學所頒其他學位完全一樣。

（3）列斯特大學自九一年起，每年均設有二千英鎊一年之二年獎學金授予成績最優的樹仁轉學生。

（4）樹仁學院圖書館備有最新出版之書刊，以協助經濟系學生準備升級考試。

#### （四）申請入學資格：

具有下列資格之一者，可申請入學：  
（1）凡本港會考合格，在註冊中學中六（F6）修讀一年者，經本校入學考試合格取錄，可入基礎課程；或

（2）本港註冊中學之中七班（G）畢業學生，在高級程度會考中，考獲兩科合格，及英文D級或以上者；可申請免考筆試，入學位課程之第一年；或

（3）曾參加倫大入學試，考獲二「A」三「O」及英文合格者；亦可申請免試入一年級；或

（4）年齡在廿一歲以上之成年學生，具有相當學術水平及良好之英文程度者，唯須參加本校於九五年八月六日（星期日）舉行之入學考試。

# Co-operative Programme in B. A. and B. Sc. (Honours) Degree in Economics between Hong Kong Shue Yan College and the University of Leicester, England

## Introduction

The programme is designed to train students in modern economic analysis and its application to the problems of business and public policy who are limited in time and resources but would like to pursue a degree course in Great Britain. Successful applicants will be able to study the first year of a three year honours degree course in Hong Kong. The syllabus, teaching materials and standards of assessment will be fully compatible with those used in first-year Economics subjects at the University of Leicester. Degrees will be awarded by the University of Leicester; degree classification will be based on studies undertaken in England, during the second and third years. Whilst both the BA and the B.Sc. degree courses follow a common core of subjects, the B.Sc.(Econ.) offers the opportunity for students with special aptitude in mathematics to apply quantitative techniques to the solution of economic problems.

## Aim

To facilitate the transfer of students from Shue Yan College, Hong Kong to the second year of the B.A. and B.Sc (Honours) Course at the University of Leicester, England.

## Structure

(A) The Honours programme is taught over three years. The first year is taught in its entirety at Shue Yan College in Hong Kong. Second and third years consisting of a total of nine papers are conducted at the University of Leicester in England. The syllabus of the first year of the cooperative programme is consistent with the programme conducted at the University of Leicester and examination papers are agreed jointly by the two institutions. The subjects offered in Hong Kong are exactly the same as schedules in the Department of Economics of Shue Yan College. The following major and subsidiary courses are to be covered:

1. Econ 101-2 Principles of Economics
2. Econ 111-2 Mathematics for Economists I & II
3. Econ 201-2 Money & Banking
4. Econ 205 Basic Economic Statistics
5. Econ 206 Intermediate Economic Statistics
6. Econ 213 Microeconomics
7. Econ 214 Macroeconomics
8. Eng 111-2 English Usage
9. Eng 211-2 English Writing
10. EDP 123 Lotus 1-2-3

Shue Yan students who have successfully completed the first year examinations will be eligible to transfer into the second year of the B.A./B.Sc.(Economics) programme at the University of Leicester.

(B) The College has conducted a Foundation Course, based substantially upon the first year of the Department of Economics Course of Shue Yan College. Students who have successfully completed one year Form 6 studies and passed the College Entrance Examination may enter the Foundation Course of this cooperative Degree Programme.

A student who completes the Foundation Course (i.e. comprising 1st year subjects of Economics Department of Shue Yan College), totalling at least 38 credit points and achieves an average of B-over all the subject marks, with at least a grade D in each individual subject mark, will be deemed eligible to be promoted to the First-Year Degree Course (equivalent to the Shue Yan College 2nd year subjects of Economics Department). Students who have been approved for promotion to the First-Year Degree Course at the College may transfer to the above degree course at Leicester University if they wish. The procedure and requirements will be same as for those admitted to the Second-Year Degree Course.

Students who fail to achieve the required standard may be allowed to advance to the First-Year Degree Course provided approval is given by the University and the College after a review of the student's performance in the Foundation Course.

## Attractions

1. Substantial savings are realized by undertaking one third of the complete courses locally, stemming from lower tuitions and living expenses.
2. The degree is awarded by the University of Leicester and is identical in every respect to that resulting from their regular programme.
3. Leicester University has instituted a scholarship of £ 2,000.00 per annum last 2 years to the best student transferring from Shue Yan College each year.
4. The Library of Shue Yan College has been expanded to include the latest publications from the United Kingdom in order to assist students to prepare for the promotion examination.

## Requirements for Admission

- (A) Entry to First Year Degree Course:-  
The minimum academic qualification is full matriculation at the Advanced Levels (HK or GCE and a good command of the English Language (demonstrated by a D in Use of English).
- (B) Entry to Foundation Course:-  
Candidates should possess the HKCEE (including Chinese and English) Plus completed one year of Form Six studies in a registered school and have passed the College Entrance Examination.
- (C) Mature students aged 21 or above with a good command of English may also apply but must sit for the College Entrance Examination.

- Process:
- i) please bring originals and copies of academic qualifications including transcripts/reports of Form 4 to Form 7, Hong Kong Identity Card and two recent passport size photographs,
  - ii) complete the admission application form, and
  - iii) submit the completed form with copies of supporting documents and a non-refundable application fee HK\$100.00.

## Entrance Examination

- (A) Each candidate must attend an interview at an appointed time arranged immediately after submitting his/her application to the Registry.
- (B) The written examination will be held on Sunday, August 6, 1995 at the College.

## Tuition

The tuition fee of HK \$21,000.00 per year is payable in two equal instalments, i.e. H.K.\$10,500.00 per semester, once paid, is non-refundable.

The tuition fee for 2nd and 3rd year is per University of Leicester schedule. Students will be required to pay an application fee of 100 British Pounds per person, for the supplementary transfer examination work and interview carried out by University of Leicester staff.
